1. **You are my _____ - Relationship & Royal Recognition—v. 7**
 - This verse is declared in Acts 13:33; Hebrews 1:5; 5:5—all showing the Son’s relationship to the Father. God is not creating this relationship; He’s acknowledging it. It was phrase used in enthronement in ancient near East.
 - Jesus, the Son, has always existed: Hebrews 1:8,10; Colossians 1:17; John 1:1; Revelation 22:13
 - “This day,” refers to resurrection day—when Jesus is declared king.
